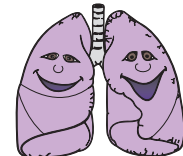
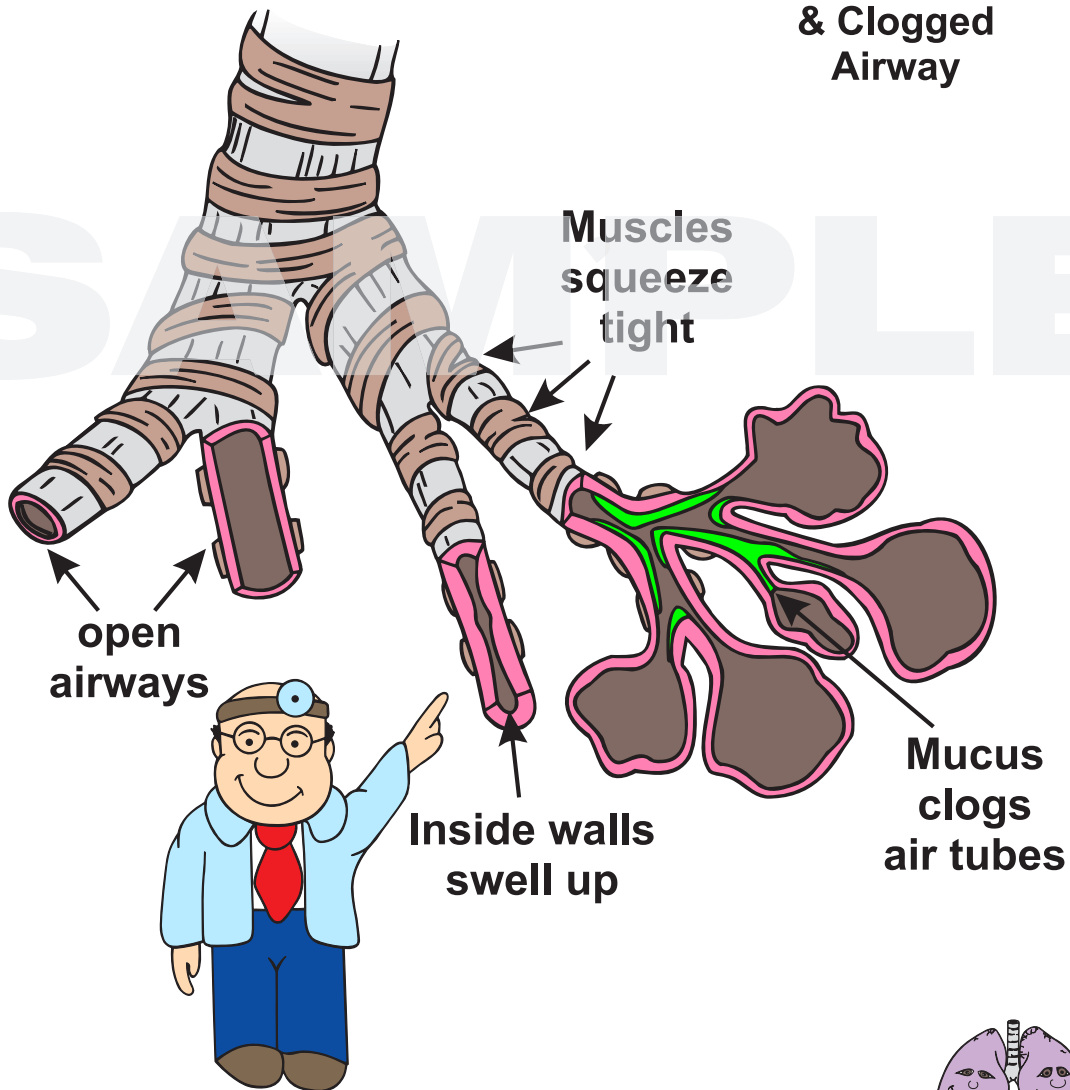
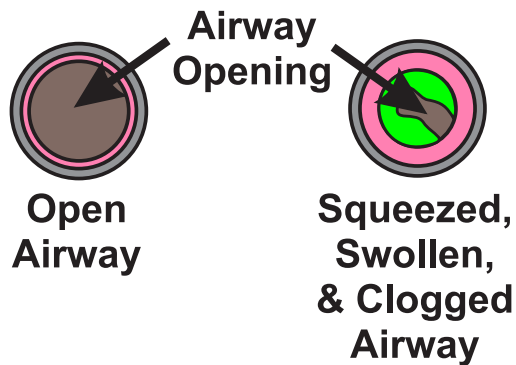


Q: Why is it so hard to breathe during an asthma attack?
